




Basic guidelines for nomination

- <u>Committed to the Catholic</u> <u>faith</u>: A baptised person and regularly participates in Sunday masses.
 - Serves the community:
 - These services are often shown through:
 - a) Ring up the priest and ask him to pray over the sick or to visit the sick member of the community in hospital.
 - b) Encourage others to go and see the priest to pray over them.
 - c) Communicate with the priest when there is a funeral in the community and when certain family in the community needs the baptism for their children.



d) In-charge of bringing water, salt, oil to be blessed by the priest for the use of the community.

e) Preparing the place for mass.

<u>Community group</u>: Nominees are from different camps and outstation communities also from different families and skin groups.

Nungalinya Student: If possible the nominee should have finished at least the certificate 3.

APPROVAL FROM THE ELDERS

- The meeting will be held by the elders and the priests to discuss whether these candidates are suitable to be the leaders in the communities. The elders can also nominate people whose name might not be on the suggested list.
- Once approved by the Elders, a letter will be sent to the Bishop with the approved candidates' names. Letter will be co-signed by the elders and the priests.

INVITATION TO TAKE UP THE RESPONSABILITY

- The bishop will then write the letter to each candidate asking them whether they will accept the responsibility.
- The letter signed by the bishop will also address each candidate why they have been chosen, for what reason they have been chosen, the process that they have to go through to serve his or her community.


THE APPROVED CANDIDATES

- Once the candidates say yes, their names will be made known to the faith community during the Sunday masses.
- A special Sunday mass will be celebrated, by the Bishop, priests and the community members, to commission these candidates, where they will make their promises to responsibly take up the process put in place to become the Catholic leaders in their communities and the whole community will pray over them.
- Discussion to find the suitable Arrente word for "Catechist," or equivalent word for Aboriginal Catholic Leaders in their communities.

Aim of the Formation



a) Empower the catechists to perform their role as Catholic leaders in their communities



 b) Enabling them to provide accurate answers to the questions posed by the growing number of sects in the communities especially the position of the Catholic Church in relation to the current issues in the Church and the world c)Enable the Catechists to run prayer services, the communion services when the priest is not around, and involve in the Sacramental Preparation Programs

d) Enable the Catechists to perform the Catholic rituals in the communities: Funerals, baptisms in case of emergency, the blessing of the sick, the blessing of the houses, ministry in schools, teaching Catechism, etc....

Basic courses to be undertaken by the Candidates

- a. Bible (history and how to use) & Lectio Divina
- b. Liturgy (Liturgical Calendar, rituals)
- c. History of the Catholic Church
- d. Sacraments
- e. Other relevant Courses as recommended by the Diocese



After the formation

- Special mass will be celebrated with anointing and the imposition of the hands by the Bishop.
- Alb (or special habit, symbol, tunic or cross) will be given to the Catechist to be put on to identify themselves from the rest of the members of the community especially during church celebrations in the community.

•Bible and Catechist ritual book (Ritual book is being put in place with simple English and prayers in the local language if possible) that will help the Catechist to do the Catholic rituals and services in the communities.

The Story of the Painting

- We have our Catechist program, leadership gathering and meeting to create the leader in our community. We gave a name for the word "Catechist" in Arrente **TYERRTYE AKNGERREPARTE**.
- We also gather each Thursday for our prayer meeting and sharing idea and preparing for Sunday's liturgy/masses. We prepare choir and liturgy. We prepare children and adults for the sacraments and also other special occasions.
- We as leaders and elders are always asking and inviting our young people to join us so they can learn from us and from the church so that they can be our next leaders in the church. It is hard to bring the young ones to involve in the church but we always have hope and pray that one day God/Ngkarte will bring them back to the church. Our biggest dream about our leadership in our community is that one day our faith, our catholic faith can be passed on to the next generations and they can continue to be faithful to their faith as well.

Story of the Painting

- Tracks and circles represent the land and our country that our ancestors have travelled. Just like Jesus have travelled with His followers and preaching the word of the Gospel.
- We also have our elders and young ones all painted up for dancing. There is clapping sticks, dancing sticks and coolamons with ochre paints and waving bands and also foot prints.





- There are also other elders sitting around and singing in circles.
- The dots represent all nations coming together in our parish.
- Together we come as church and learn about faith and culture from each other.
